About the IAP2 Certificate Program in Public Participation

The International Association for Public Participation (IAP2) Certificate Program in Public Participation will show you how to build a foundation for planning, designing and implementing effective public participation programs. This is a three module program (5 days) developed in consultation with practitioners from around the world, and the training provides useful tools that you can begin using immediately. Students will receive credit from IAP2 for completing each module, and after completing all three modules, you will receive an IAP2 Certificate in Public Participation.

MODULE 1: PLANNING FOR EFFECTIVE PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Have you ever asked the question: "How do I get meaningful input from stakeholders and use it in a constructive way?" Then this course is for you. This two-day module provides an introduction to the foundations of effective public participation programs. Through a five-step planning process, participants will learn how to set clear objectives, determine the appropriate level of public participation and deliver on a promise to the public. Other important topics include the practical application of the IAP2 Core Values for Public Participation and the use of the IAP2 Code of Ethics as a guide to both practitioners and clients. *Note: Module 1 is a prerequisite for Modules 2 & 3.

MODULE 2: COMMUNICATIONS FOR EFFECTIVE PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

This single day module offers an overview and introduction to the communication skills used by public participation practitioners. It introduces the Principles of Authentic Communication and the need to consider the variety of learning styles practitioners must think about in preparing communication materials.

MODULE 3: TECHNIQUES FOR EFFECTIVE PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

So now you have your plan together, how do you ensure the dialogue is constructive and meaningful? This two-day module provides an introduction to a range of practical tools and techniques used at all five levels of the IAP2 Public Participation Spectrum. It gives course participants an opportunity to try out or observe a number of specific techniques, including World Cafe, Interviews, Card Storming, Appreciative Inquiry and Open Space.

IAP2 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION FOR DECISION MAKERS

Do you want your senior administrators to know more about why public participation is important? This course focuses on the public participation foundations from a decision maker's point of view. It examines the costs and benefits of public participation, discusses when and when not to involve the public in an organizational decision, and emphasizes the importance of both the decision being made and the promise to the public about their involvement in that decision process. Finally, the session provides an overview of what the decision maker should know about the role of the public participation practitioner.
